Supervisor Jones,

I was forwarded the following post that Town Clerk Lisa Dolan made to a Facebook Group for the Town of Fenner, regarding the drone overflights we are conducting:

"no they are under no obligation to tell us anything, as you know we have a law against industrial solar in Fenner. We have no relationship with any wind or solar company at this time My guess is they have permission from certain land owners to be on certain properties"

I find the Town Clerk's quote interesting in that (1) we notified you directly of the drone overflights; (2) we keep you informed of our activities in the Town; (3) we repeatedly request that we establish a regularly scheduled status call/meeting to keep the Town apprised of ongoing developments and the lines of communication open; and (4) I am always available via phone or in-person if you have any questions.

We advise you of our activities ***precisely*** so that you are informed, in case you get an inquiry from a Town resident about the Oxbow Hill Solar Project.

I reiterate my request that we establish a regularly scheduled status call/meeting to keep the Town apprised of ongoing developments and the lines of communication open.

Supervisor Jones,

Be advised that Cypress Creek has consultants working in the Town of Fenner conducting field studies in support of our State Permit Application; this work will continue through September.

We have consultants conducting cultural resource investigations on the project parcels. This investigation includes shovel testing.

We are also commencing a magnetometer survey to identify any potential active or inactive oil and gas wells. This survey is conducted using drone overflights and is again focused on project parcels. The magnetometer survey may commence as early as the end of this week.

I reiterate my request that we establish a regularly scheduled status call/meeting to keep the Town apprised of ongoing developments and the lines of communication open.
